Building Islamic Knowledge

Education remains a key responsibility at ICM, enabling growth through Islamic learning and character building.

Qur'an Hifz Program:

- 12 Students (10 boys & 2 girls) completed memorization of the Qur'an this year.
- Honoured during the Hifz Graduation Ceremony.

Islamic Education Programs:

- Weekly Tafsir & Seerah Classes Focused on understanding the Qur'an and Sunnah.
- Youth Halaqas Strengthening Islamic identity among youth.
- Guest Scholars Sessions by Shaikh Ousaama Hafid, Sheikh Shoaib Wardak, and others.

Summer Camp 2024:

- 150+ Children participated.
- Activities included Islamic Studies, STEM projects, and field trips.
- Olympics Week and an End-of-Camp Jalsa celebrated their achievements.

Educational Infrastructure Projects:

- Renovation of classrooms and upstairs facilities completed.
- Accessibility Upgrades Elevator project underway for seniors and differentlyabled community members.

In light of rising Islamophobia, we have implemented advanced security systems to safeguard our community:

- Automated East Entrance Gate.
- License Plate Reader (LPR) Cameras at both gates.
- Expanded Video Surveillance with longer storage capabilities.
- Security Film for Windows Protection against break-ins.
- Video-Enabled Intercom System For controlled access.
- On-Demand Security Personnel and Police Support.

Sports Complex Upgrades:

- Renovated Change Rooms and modern lighting systems.
- Youth Programs Volleyball leagues, FitNisa programs, and tournaments.
- Annual Sports Festival Promoting health and teamwork.

Community Events:

- Graduation Jalsa 2024 Recognizing student achievements.
- Workshops and Seminars Covering parenting, finances, and mental health.



Report on Finished, Active & Planned Projects

Project #1: Brother's Wudu Area and Washrooms Remodeling & Renovations

<u>Scope:</u> Remodeling of the Wudu area and washrooms, including renovations to five additional washrooms across the 1st and 2nd floors.

Present Estimate: \$160,000

Funds Collected & Source: \$163,000 (Community & other Masajid contributions)

Funds Used: \$150,000

Status: Completed

Project #2: Sister's Wudu Area and Washrooms Remodeling & Renovations

Scope: Remodeling of the Wudu area and washrooms on the 1st floor.

Present Estimate: \$90,000

Funds Collected & Source: \$41,800 (Community contributions)

Funds Used: Work just started

Status: In Progress

Project #3: Upstairs Renovation Including Paint

Scope: Painting and general renovations.

Present Estimate: \$25,000

Funds Collected & Source: \$21,132 (Community contributions during Ramadan)

<u>Funds Used</u>: \$22,625

Status: Completed



Report on Finished, Active & Planned Projects

Project #4: Additional Security Measures together with Security Infrastructure Program (SIP)

<u>Scope:</u> Enhancements to physical security, including surveillance systems, protective barriers, lighting, intrusion detection systems, security-grade window film, anti-graffiti spray, physical access controls, and more.

Total Project Cost: \$220,000

Cost Covered by SIP: \$93,512 (Government contribution)

Funds Collected & Source: \$126,488 (Community contributions)

Status: Completed

Project #5: Elevator and Accessibility for Seniors and Special Needs

<u>Scope:</u> Renovation of four existing doors, installation of one new accessible exterior door, and an elevator.

Present Estimate: \$160,000

<u>Funds Collected & Source:</u> \$100,000 (Government grant)

Funds Used: \$54,812

<u>Status:</u> In Progress (Design drawings, lift selection, & architect permit drawings completed. Quote under review. Delays due to City & Fire Department involvement.)

Project #6: Complete Funeral Facilities

Scope: Establishment of funeral facilities at southeast corner of the building.

Present Estimate: \$300,000

Funds Collected & Source: \$108,579 (Community contributions)

Funds Used: \$1,149

Status: In Progress (Design drawings completed & submitted to City - awaiting approvals)



Project #7: Accessible Doors and Website Accessibility

Scope: Renovation/installation of six accessible doors and making the website accessible.

Present Estimate: In process

Funds Collected & Source: \$92,000 (Government grant)

Status: In Progress
