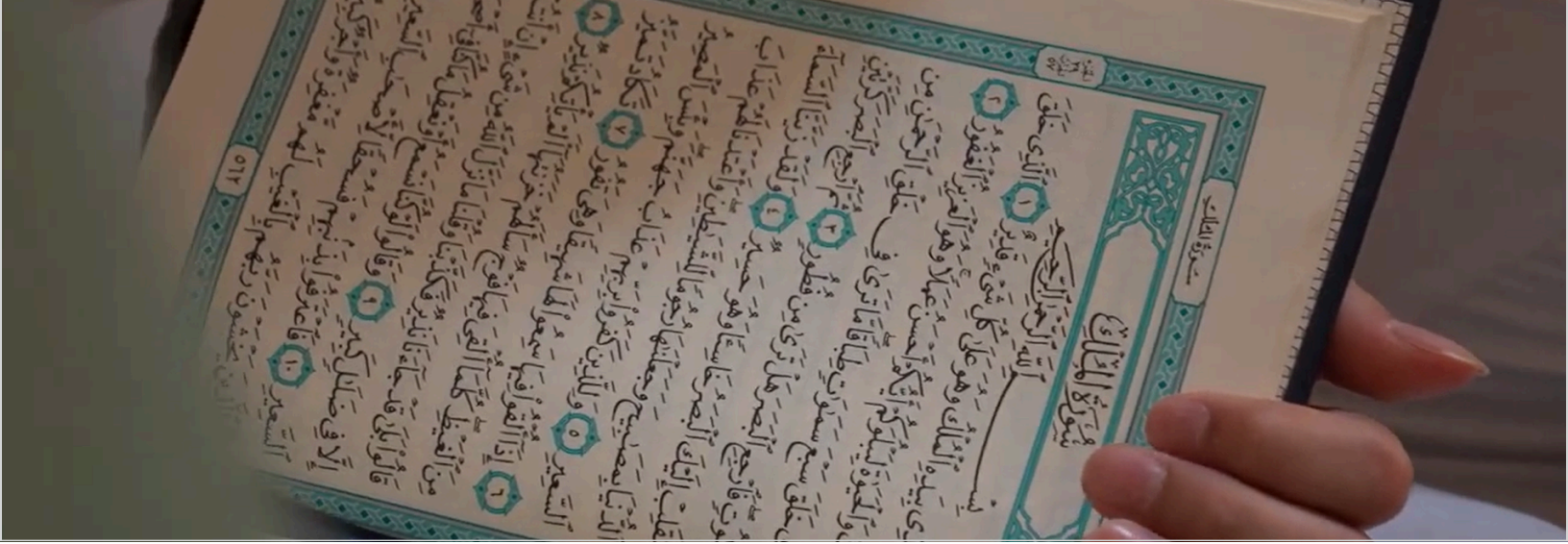

Course Description

This course is designed to equip adult and senior community members with the skills and confidence to independently study the meanings of the Qur'an (tafsir) using reliable digital tools and online resources.

Participants will be guided step-by-step on how to effectively use applications such as the Quran App (Quran.com), along with other trusted online platforms, to access translations, classical tafsir works, and scholarly explanations. The course emphasizes a sound methodology (manhaj) in approaching tafsir, ensuring that students engage with authentic sources while avoiding misinterpretation.

Course Content

Key areas of focus include:

- Understanding the structure and navigation of Qur'an apps and websites
- Accessing and comparing reliable English translations
- Introduction to recognized tafsir works (e.g., Ibn Kathir, al-Jalalayn) in accessible formats
- Developing a consistent personal study routine
- Learning how to verify sources and avoid unreliable content online
- Applying reflection (tadabbur) in a structured and meaningful way



The course is tailored specifically for elders, with a paced, supportive teaching style that accommodates varying levels of digital familiarity. Hands-on guidance will be provided to ensure all participants can confidently use the required tools.



Program Objectives

By the end of the course, participants will:

- Be able to independently navigate Qur'an study apps and websites
- Understand how to access and benefit from foundational tafsir literature
- Develop a sustainable habit of personal Qur'an study
- Gain confidence in engaging with the Qur'an beyond recitation



Format

- Instructor-led sessions with live demonstrations
- Guided, hands-on practice during class time
- Optional take-home exercises for reinforcement
